Your child may be entered for the Royal Academy of Dance ballet examinations if the criteria of class preparations are met and although this is not compulsory, children enjoy the sense of achievement that taking part and success can bring. We also produce exciting shows at The Dergate approximately every two years which create memorable experiences for all our pupils and their families.

Ballet and character shoes will always be checked for fit by the teacher, but please do double check you that you are happy with all sizing.
- Invoices will be emailed in advance of each term or at the time your child begins classes. All ballet fees and related ballet fees are through Northamptonshire School of Dance (not Spratton Hall School).
- Parents are asked not to enter the hall during classes, but will be invited to watch classes at the end of most terms.
