All the young artists need to do is design a Coronation-themed picture on an A4 piece of paper which, if chosen, will be printed onto a card. Entry is limited to one design per child and all entries must be received by **Friday 7th April at 5 pm**. Artists should include their full name, age, school, and address with their entry.
