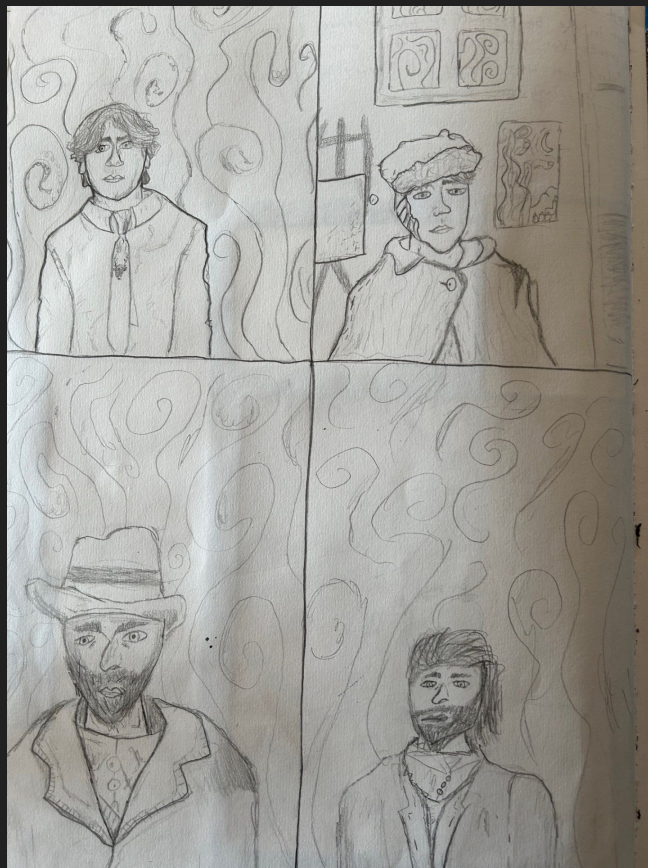

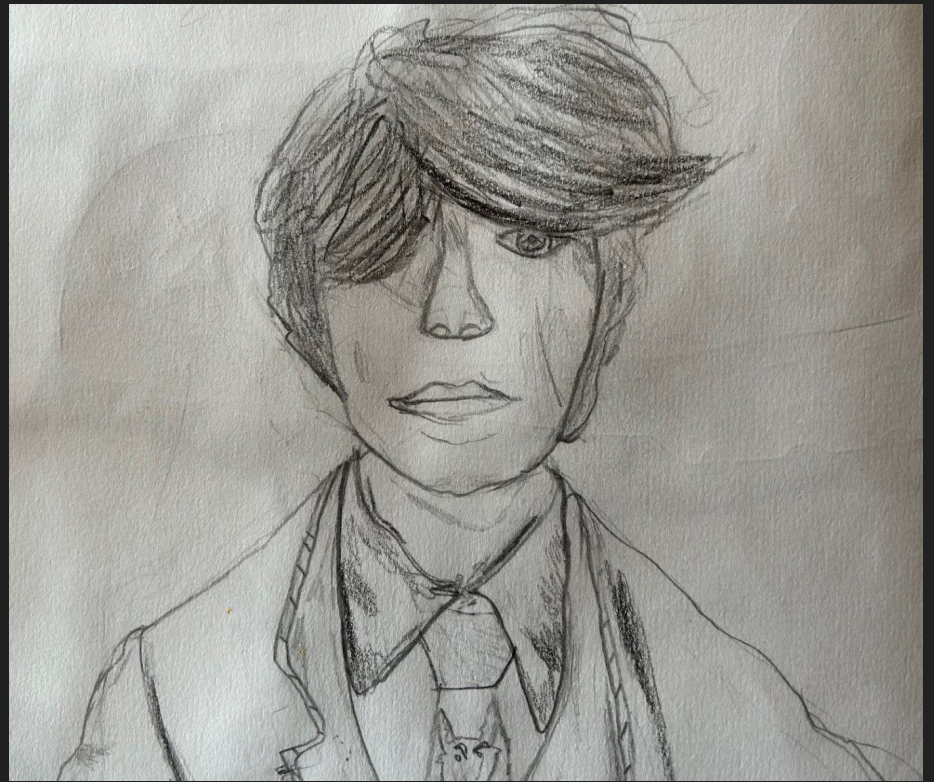


Vincent Van Gogh

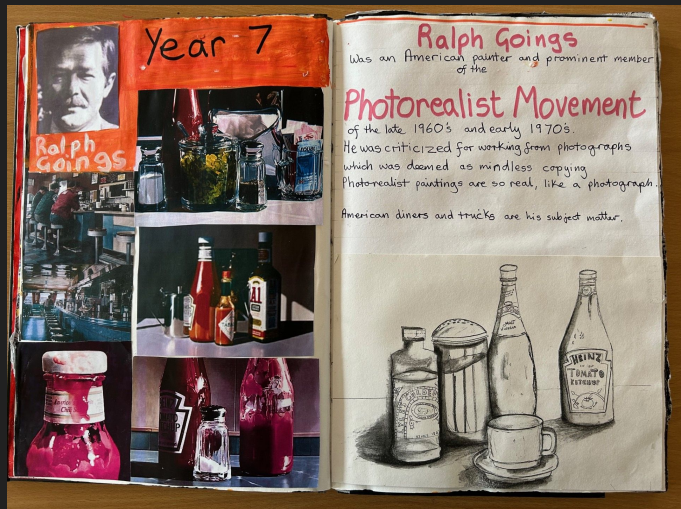

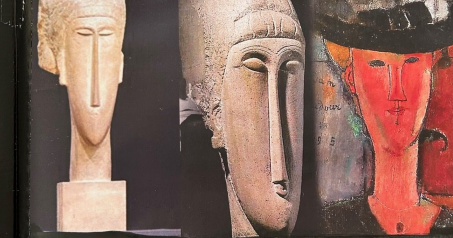

stylized.

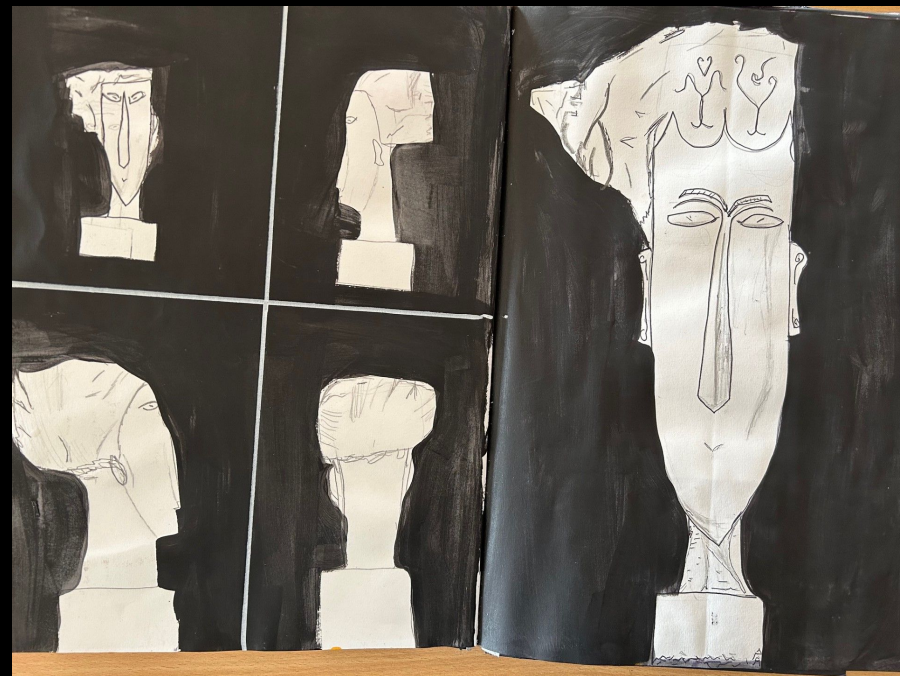


Amedeo Modigliani's stone Carved Heads
